The Cape Royal Community Foundation, Inc. is pleased to announce to the Lee County High Schools that the foundation will be accepting applications for **four** scholarships of \$5000 each that will be awarded to two male students and to two female students. These students must be members of the high school golf teams, have a good academic record and be involved in other school and community activities. These students must continue their post-secondary education in an institution of higher education to include technical schools starting in the summer or fall of 2021. Four scholarships totaling \$20,000 will be awarded this year.

ELIGIBILITY

- be a resident of Lee County
- be a member of a Lee County High School's golf team
- be a graduating senior accepted at, and planning to attend, an accredited college, university, or vocational technical school during the summer or fall of 2023

REQUIREMENTS

- a list of high school activities/clubs/sports (20 points)
- a list of community activities/work experience (20 points)
- two letters of recommendation: one from a teacher, counselor, golf coach, or administrator of the high school attended; one letter from a non-school source such as pastor, employer, or community member, but <u>not</u> from family or relatives (10 points each = total of 20 points)
- applicant's comments in an essay on the importance of the scholarship (20 points)
- rating from Golf Coach (20 points)
- must present evidence of acceptance at a post-secondary educational institution
- OFFICIAL COPY* of High School Transcript must be included (10 points)
 - *The transcript must be stamped or signed by a school official.

Applications for the scholarships must be received by April 12, 2023

REVIEW AND AWARD All completed applications will be reviewed without regard to race, religion, or ethnicity. Scholarship awards will be made directly to the post secondary schools of the recipients prior to the beginning of their attendance.
